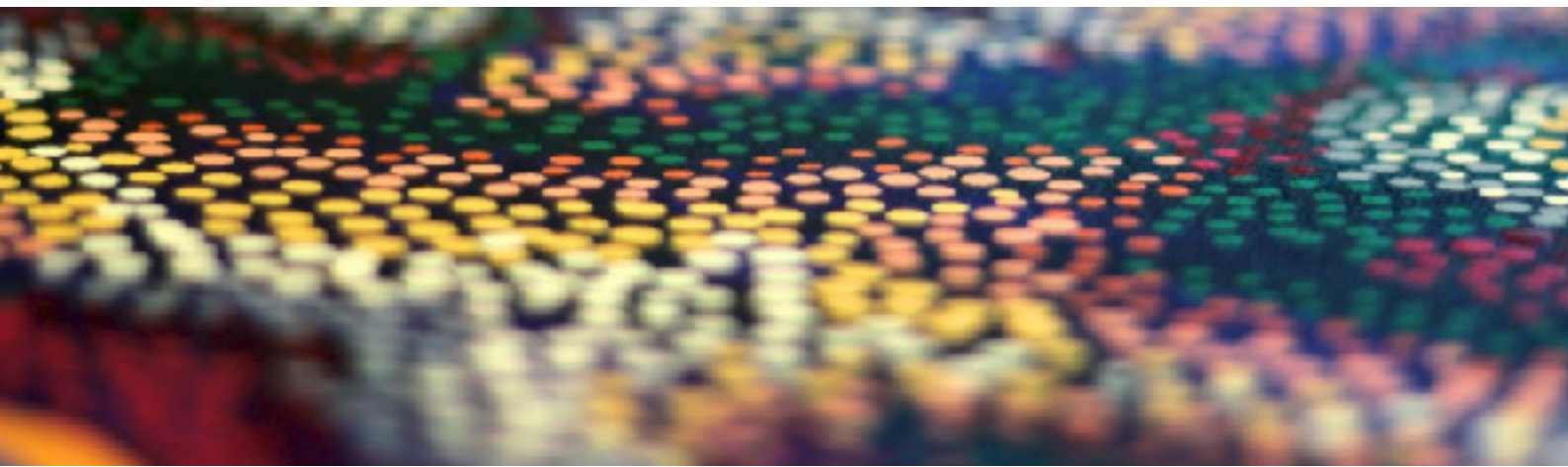


# INDIGENOUS LAND MANAGEMENT PATHWAY
